Please read the notes below before completing your Application Form

1. When you join the club (F.A.C. holder or not) you will be classed as a Probationary Member for a period of 3 months. During this you will be expected to attend the Range at least 12 times. It is your responsibility to check your attendances are recorded (Attendance Record Card in Application Pack).
2. At the end of your probation, your application for full membership will be submitted to the Membership Committee who may or may not grant full membership.
3. Only when full membership has been granted will the Club Secretary be authorised to support your F.A.C. application (a legal requirement).
4. Non-certificate holders are expected to apply for their Firearms Certificate within 6 months of joining the Club. Failure to apply after 12 months will result in termination of membership.
5. long term storage at the Range is not permitted.
6. Any firearms acquired by a Member must be written on the Member's F.A.C.
7. Members must observe all Range safety rules and requirements and are expected to report any observed infringements to the Range Control Officer (R.C.O) IMMEDIATELY.
8. You must not remove ammunition (or fired cases) from the Range if it had not been entered on your F.A.C. Unused rounds must be handed into the R.C.O., they will be labeled and returned to you at your next visit.
9. Please note that membership must be renewed by 1st July each Year. If your subs have not been paid by the 1st of August, your membership will be terminated and your Police Authority informed. After this time, If you wish to rejoin the Club, you will be required to pay the full year's subscription backdated to the 1st of July.
10. Details of all prospective members are sent to South Wales Police, and when you apply for your F.A.C. (mandatory) your application will be vetted by your local Police Authority, Special Branch, if required MI5.

Note: The Rehabilitation of Offenders Act DOES NOT apply to F.A.C. applications.
